

MODULE 14 BSL-2, Bloodborne Pathogens and Herpes B Virus Training. This is a 2 hour class required for anyone working with recombinant or synthetic nucleic acids or pathogenic/toxic materials requiring BSL2 containment AND work with Macaques, including unfixed samples and cells. This class also includes information on Bloodborne Pathogens for those working with human or non-human primate cell lines, blood, tissue, body fluids, as well as other potentially infectious material (OPIM) of human origin: this includes work with established cell lines. The risks associated with the potential exposure to Herpes B virus and procedures to follow in the event of an exposure are described. **Training must be completed at the time of assignment and repeated annually.** Information regarding the class, and how to register for a class, can be found by contacting the Biosafety officer at Biosafety@ehs.utah.edu.
