MODULE 7 Laboratory/Protocol-Specific training. All personnel must receive training from the Principal Investigator, at the time of assignment and at least annually thereafter. This training must include a risk assessment for any microbial agents being used in the lab (including routes of infection, signs and symptoms of exposure and options for vaccinations or post-exposure prophylaxis), engineering and work practice controls, PPE requirements, spill clean-up procedures, and post-exposure procedures, as applicable. Laboratories with a comprehensive Biosafety manual may use this for training, with signatures documenting review. In person trainings, for example during lab meetings, can also be documented using the "Site-Specific Training Checklist and Record SOP" in the IBC Fact Sheets and SOP library.
